RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE SCHEDULE
OF FEES FOR RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS
AND FOOD SERVICE OPERATIONS FOR THE
2022 LICENSING YEAR

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 3717.25 and 3717.45 of the Ohio Revised Code and Sections 901.3-4-03 and 3701-21 of the Ohio Administrative Code, the Board has the authority to set fees for food service establishments and food service operations;

WHEREAS, the Environmental Health Division, in collaboration with the Fiscal Division, performed the cost methodology based on 2020 data to establish our fees for the 2022 operating/licensing year; and

WHEREAS, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goal #4 of sustainable funding.

Now, therefore, upon motion of Board Member _____, seconded by Board Member _____.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS:

1. That the retail food establishment and food service operation fees for the 2022 operating/approval year are adopted effective ten (10) days from the date of the first publication in accordance with Section 3709.09(E).
2. That the Board directs the Health Commissioner, to notify each person or government entity holding a retail food establishment or food service operation license of the proposed fee increases and their opportunity to attend a public hearing on November 9, 2021.
3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
