RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO RENEW A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY TO ASSIST WITH THE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SPECIALISTS NETWORK GRANT (EXPENSE NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been awarded a grant from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention through the Environmental Health Specialists Network (EHS-Net) Practice Based Research to Improve Safety Grant;

WHEREAS, a significant component of the EHS-Net Grant is to conduct practice-based research in order to improve food safety;

WHEREAS, FCPH is need of assistance with development of the study design and research plan, data analysis, and IRB approval; and

WHEREAS, The Ohio State University has the expertise to provide the services needed; and

WHEREAS, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goal #4 of sustainable funding and Public Health Accreditation Board Domains 1 and 10.
