RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM THE ASSOCIATION OF FOOD AND DRUG OFFICIALS FOR THE MANAGED RETAIL PROGRAM STANDARDS GRANT PROGRAM (Revenue of \$25,542.10)
