RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO REVISE ITS SOFTWARE AND LICENSING AGREEMENT WITH ARMORVAX LLC FOR COVID-19 VACCINATION MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE (EXPENSE NOT TO EXCEED \$18,000)

WHEREAS, ArmorVax, LLC provides a software application to streamline the vaccination process for consumers and reduce the administrative burden for medical providers;

WHEREAS, ArmorVax, LLC can provide vaccination management software in a manner that meets national standards of HIPAA compliance and confidentiality of patient health information;

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) entered into a software and licensing agreement with Armorvax, LLC for a mass vaccination management software for its COVID-19 clinics in January 2021; and

WHEREAS, FCPH has the opportunity to purchase rights to the ArmorVax software including all the vaccination records and documents currently in the system for a one-time cost of \$17,500 and an annual service charge of \$500

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to revise its software and licensing agreement with ArmorVax LLC for COVID-19 vaccination management software system. (expense not to exceed \$18,000).
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
