SPECIALISTS NETWORK (EHS-NET) PRACTICE  
BASED RESEARCH TO IMPROVE FOOD SAFETY  
(Revenue of \$191,950.00)

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been awarded federal funding through the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Environmental Health Specialists Network (EHS-Net) Practice Based Research to Improve Safety (Award # 5 U01EH001362-03-00);

**WHEREAS**, FCPH seeks to accept federal funding for 2022-2023, to continue expanding efforts to address food safety;

**WHEREAS**, with this grant FCPH seeks to leverage health inspection data to better understand how new food safety training requirements for managers relate to critical violations for the most frequent contributing factors to retail-related outbreaks of foodborne illness; and

**WHEREAS**, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goal of sustainable funding.
