

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY NISONGER CENTER (OSU) IN SUPPORT OF THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION (CDC) OHIO DISABILITY AND HEALTH GRANT (REVENUE OF \$10,000.00).

WHEREAS, OSU has been awarded grant funding through the CDC to improve the health and wellness of people with disabilities by linking people with unmet healthcare and social service needs to tailored services, where the primary responsibility is for one Community Health Worker (CHW) to maintain a client caseload through the HUB by targeting adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD); and

WHEREAS, FCPH would provide staffing support (i.e. join Care Coordination Section meetings, collaboration and shadowing of FCPH CHW), part-time office support/placement, and supervision of signing off on all pathways, checklists and tools within the Care Coordination System platform; and

WHEREAS, OSU would offer tailored IDD training, educational materials and resources to all FCPH CHWs so that CHWs may provide equitable services for all current and future clients served; and

WHEREAS, OSU will manage all HR responsibilities, as well as be responsible for all financial responsibilities of CHW position; and

WHEREAS, FCPH will receive all HUB reimbursement revenue through Managed Care Plans based on the completed checklists, pathways and tools by the CHW; and

WHEREAS, through this partnership, FCPH would be able to expand the reach in CHW services and knowledge to address Franklin County's HealthMap 2022 priority areas of basic needs and racial equity.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Board of Health authorizes the Health Commissioner to enter into contract with the Ohio State University Nisonger Center in support of the CDC's Ohio Disability and Health Grant. (Revenue of \$10,000.00).
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
