

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH OHIO UNIVERSITY (OU) TO PROVIDE EVALUATION SERVICES IN SUPPORT OF THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION'S (CDC) COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKERS (CHW) FOR COVID RESPONSE AND RESILIENT COMMUNITIES (CCR) GRANT. (EXPENSE OF \$125,100.00)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been awarded year two (2) continuation funding from CDC through the Community Health Workers for COVID Response and Resilient Communities (CCR) Grant and seeks to contract with Ohio University for evaluation services; and

WHEREAS, Ohio University will provide evaluation efforts in the form of data reports, quarterly summaries of CHW training needs and annual evaluation reports for the Community Health Workers for COVID Response and Resilient Communities (CCR) Grant; and

WHEREAS, Ohio University's evaluation efforts of the programmatic outcomes will aid the Care Coordination Division to measure CHW and client engagements in support of PHAB Domain 9, Standard 9.1: Use a Performance Management System to Monitor Achievement of Organizational Objectives; and

WHEREAS, Ohio University's evaluation efforts of identifying CHW training needs will aid the Care Coordination Division in identifying performance and training gaps of CHWs in support of PHAB Domain 9, Standard 9.2: Develop and Implement Quality Improvement Processes Integrated Into Organizational Practice, Programs, Processes, and Interventions.

(Expense of \$125,100.00)
