

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY AND CITY OFFICIALS (NACCHO) FOR THE GRANT PROJECT OF "PREPARING FOR WASH-RELATED EMERGENCIES AMONG PEOPLE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS" BETWEEN AUGUST 1, 2022, TO MAY 31, 2023. (Revenue of \$42,000.00)

WHEREAS, the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) provides grant funding to complete the workplan outlined within "Preparing for Wash-Related Emergencies Among People Experiencing Homelessness" for Franklin County residents; and

WHEREAS, through support from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Franklin County Public Health is one of only five awardees for the project nationally; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Preparedness staff will oversee the workplan outlined in the Scope of Work including: Monthly Calls, creation of an emergency WASH Plan for Franklin County, and the testing of the plan with partners throughout Franklin County, as well as a presentation at the NACCHO Preparedness Summit in 2023;

WHEREAS, the project will be completed during the period of August 1, 2022 – May 31, 2023;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into a contract with National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) to complete grant required Scop of Work with a revenue of \$42,000.00 based on the terms and conditions of the contract.
2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect on August 1, 2022, through May 31, 2023.
