RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO AMEND A CONTRACT WITH AMÉLIE COMPANY TO EXPAND AND EXECUTE THE "RECOVER FOR LIFE" CAMPAIGN AND OTHER COMMUNICATION MESSAGING AS PART OF THE CDC OPIATE DATA TO ACTION GRANT (EXPENSE OF \$20,000.00 – OD2A Grant)

**WHEREAS**, per Resolution 22-139, the Board approved a contract with the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA) as an organization necessary to reach athletes and parents regarding the dangers of opioids and addiction;

**WHEREAS**, OHSAA has existing systems and outreach avenues that will be used to increase the number of high school athletic programs that adopt opioid prevention and education messaging;

**WHEREAS**, to complete the work for that contract the "Recover for Life" campaign assets will need to be amended and expanded to include education messaging for parents, coaches & athletic trainers on the risks of opiate pain relief, viable alternatives & symptoms that indicate potential addiction among young athletes; and

**WHEREAS**, the current contract with the Amelie Company needs to be amended to complete this work.
