RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO SIGN A CONTRACT WITH OHIO PUBLIC HEALTH ASSOCIATION (EXPENSE OF \$12,920.00).

WHEREAS, FCPH submitted reaccreditation materials in to the Public Heath Accreditation Board on March 30, 2022;

WHEREAS, the next steps of the reaccreditation process is a site visit review with PHAB reviewers to review our submission materials with agency staff leads on the twelve domains;

WHEREAS, OPHA can provide a temporary staffing resource that is available to help prepare materials and staff, facilitate and participate in meetings with staff for strategic planning and quality improvement; and provide recommendations in preparation for virtual site visit by PHAB;

WHEREAS, OPHA resource will help organize and participate in meetings with PHAB visitors, related to and as part of the site visit, dates TBA. They will provide leadership and expertise on topics of performance management, quality, and strategy; and

WHEREAS, OPHA resource will help FCPH document all work processes to PHAB standards and assist leadership team in maintaining quality standards of a PHAB accredited health department.
