RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH COMMUNICATEHEALTH IN SUPPORT OF GRANT DELIVERABLES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES (HHS), OFFICE OF MINORITY HEALTH (OMH), AND ADVANCING HEALTH LITERACY (AHL) TO ENHANCE EQUITABLE COMMUNITY RESPONSES TO COVID-19 GRANT (Expense of \$ 36,000.00)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been awarded funding from the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) through the Advancing Health Literacy Grant; and

WHEREAS, to the goal of the Advancing Health Literacy Grant is to advance COVID-19 Health Literacy efforts with strong collaboration among local entities; and

WHEREAS, FCPH intends to contract with CommunicateHealth to deliver a digital health literacy and accessible design training series that will enable community based and healthcare organizations to ensure their health information is easy to access, understand, and use;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

That the Board of Health authorizes the Health Commissioner to enter into a contract with CommunicateHealth in support of grant deliverables for the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Office of Minority Health (OMH), and Advance Health Literacy (AHL) to enhance equitable community responses to COVID-19 (Expense Not to Exceed \$ 36,000.00).
