RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER A INTO A CONTRACT EXTENSION AND DATA USE AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO MANAGE THE COVID-19 ANALYTICS AND TARGETED SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM (CATS) AND PROVIDE VACCINE EQUITY MAPPING SUPPORT
(NO COST EXTENSION OF THE ORIGINAL AMOUNT OF \$85,927.00)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) continues to lead the public health response to the COVID-19 pandemic within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, school district and public health leaders partnered with The Ohio State University College of Public Health to build a comprehensive school surveillance system to provide data on emerging trends in COVID-19 cases within and surrounding the school districts of Franklin County;

WHEREAS, the following data points were used to build the school surveillance system: school nurse visits among students, absences among students/staff and community spread of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, equitable vaccination distribution efforts remain a priority of FCPH; and

WHEREAS, The Ohio State University College of Public Health has developed a Franklin County vaccine equity mapping tool that FCPH utilizes in its decision making internally and with community partners to increase vaccine uptake in areas of low vaccination rates; and

WHEREAS, The original contract amount of \$85,927.00 has not been fully expensed, and work will continue to lead the public health response to the COVID-19 pandemic within its jurisdiction from 2022 – 2023
