

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ACCEPT YEAR THREE SUPPLEMENTED EXTENSION GRANT FUNDING FROM THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION (CDC) THROUGH ITS OVERDOSE DATA TO ACTION (OD2A) GRANT. (REVENUE OF \$3,509,855.00)
