RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH LOCAL AGENCIES IN SUPPORT OF THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION (CDC) OVERDOSE DATA TO ACTION (OD2A) GRANT. (EXPENSE OF \$2,026,462.16)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been awarded a grant from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention through the Overdose to Action (OD2A) Grant and seeks to contract with the following agencies in support of the (OD2A) grant: Columbus Public Health (CPH); Ohio Association of Community Health Centers (OACHC); The Ohio State University College of Public Health (OSUCPH); Educational Service Center of Central Ohio (ESCCO); Franklin County Coroner's Office (FCCO); Office of Justice Policy and Programs (OJPP); Ohio University (OU); Equitas Health; African American Male Wellness Agency (AAMWA); City of Columbus-Public Safety Division; and Mighty Crow Media (MCM);

WHEREAS, FCPH seeks to expand its efforts to address the Opioid Crisis with strong collaboration among local agencies, and the support of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) through this Overdose Data to Action (OD2A) grant; and

WHEREAS, with this grant FCPH will continue its work creating an infrastructure to support data integration, further develop, expand, and implement evidence-based strategies to establish opioid prevention and surveillance activities, and ultimately reduce the number of opioid related fatalities within Franklin County.
