RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO 5 YEAR LEASE AGREEMENTS WITH ENTERPRISE FLEET MANAGEMENT FOR 2 CHEVROLET MALIBU VEHICLES (ANNUAL EXPENSE OF \$9,590.16)

WHEREAS Franklin County Public Health has a need for 2 vehicles in the CDC Overdose to Action Fund for transportation needs of community health workers, and;

WHEREAS; Franklin County Public Health, the Franklin County Purchasing Department and Franklin County Fleet Management currently participate in a cooperative purchasing agreement that provides costs, terms, and conditions for leasing vehicles with Sourcewell and Enterprise Fleet management and;

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health, will obtain and utilize quotes for dealer available 2022 Chevrolet Malibu sedans, with specifications from Enterprise Fleet Management utilizing Sourcewell cooperative purchasing pricing, terms, and conditions and;

WHEREAS; utilizing cooperative purchasing provides efficient financial management and will assist in meeting strategy 1, objective 4 of the Strategic plan

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter a contract with Enterprise Fleet Management to lease 2 vehicles for the CDCO2A Fund not to exceed \$9,590.16 annually and \$47,950.80 for the 5 year full-term lease agreement.
