**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 3730.03 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 3701-09-03 of the Ohio Administrative Code, the Board has the authority to set fees for body art businesses;

**WHEREAS**, the Environmental Health Division, in collaboration with the Fiscal Division, performed the cost methodology based on 2021 data to establish fees for the 2023 operating/approval year; and

**WHEREAS**, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goal #4 of sustainable funding.
