RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE SCHEDULE  
OF FEES FOR RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS  
AND FOOD SERVICE OPERATIONS FOR THE  
2023 LICENSING YEAR

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Sections 3717.25 and 3717.45 of the Ohio Revised Code and Sections 901.3-4-03 and 3701-21 of the Ohio Administrative Code, the Board has the authority to set fees for food service establishments and food service operations;

**WHEREAS**, the Environmental Health Division, in collaboration with the Fiscal Division, performed the cost methodology based on 2020 data to establish fees for the 2023 operating/licensing year; and

**WHEREAS**, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goal #4 of sustainable funding.

2. That the Board directed the Health Commissioner, and the Health Commissioner notified each person or government entity holding a retail food establishment or food service operation license of the proposed fee increases and their opportunity to attend this public hearing on October 11, 2022.
3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
