RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE MID-OHIO REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION (MORPC) FOR FUNDING ASSESSMENTS AND HEALTHY HOMES INVESTIGATIONS FOR THE HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) HEALTHY HOMES PRODUCTION GRANT AWARDED TO MORPC (REVENUE OF \$186,361.00)

WHEREAS, the Mid Ohio Regional Planning Commission (hereinafter "MORPC") was awarded the HUD Healthy Homes Production Grant;

WHEREAS, the grant requires Healthy Homes initial assessments and investigations;

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health has the necessary experience and expertise to provide said services;

WHEREAS, this funding from MORPC will pay for staff training in Healthy Homes assessments as well as investigations requested by MORPC and the public; and

WHEREAS, this resolution supports Franklin County Public Health Strategic Goals 1, 3 and 4.
