RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO AMEND THE CONTRACT AGREEMENT WITH VICTOR OLSZEWSKI FOR PLUMBING INSPECTION SERVICES (EXPENSE: \$26,000)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) approved through resolution 21-153 on October 12, 2021, to enter into a contract with Victor Olszewski to conduct plumbing inspections for contracted cities, villages and townships for residents of the General Health District;

WHEREAS, FCPH approved through Resolution 22-020 on February 8, 2022, a first contract amendment increasing the contract amount by \$110,000 and not to exceed \$155,000 in total; and

WHEREAS, FCPH remains in need of plumbing inspection services to meet inspection request demand and provide back-up services when needed, and wishes to amend the existing contract with Victor Olszewski a second time by increasing the amount \$26,000 and not to exceed \$181,000 in total;

Now, therefore, upon motion of Board Member _____, second by Board Member _____;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to amend an agreement with Victor Olszewski for plumbing inspection services by increasing the amount by \$26,000.00 and not to exceed \$181,000.00 in total.
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
