Proposed fees for 2023 were determined by conducting a cost methodology using 2021 data, as per the Ohio Administrative Code. Below is a table that outlines the fees and number of facilities in 2021, along with the proposed 2023 fees and the associated percentage increase.

Background:

- We did not raise fees for 2022 despite 2020 data showing operating at a deficit because of concerns that extra revenue from delayed licensing deadline (due to Covid) could exceed program costs.
- Despite the extra revenue, our 2021 program costs (\$26,328) still exceeded our revenue by \$4,647 for an operating deficit of -17.7%
- In 2021, we had one time-limited body art event which operated at a 45% deficit.

Rationale for a 24% increase in fees:

As of 8/10/2022, we are up to 91 approved body art businesses. New businesses require more staff time than established businesses,

	late 2021, all staff working in the Body Art	
	Program saw significant wage increases which	drives up our program costs.

Even if program costs were to hold steady from 2021 to 2022 (which is unlikely), at our current number of approvals (91), we would still be operating at a 22% deficit with the fee increase.

Recommendation:

It is in FCPH's best interest to increase fees for 2023. We have been operating at a deficit for a few years, and program costs continue to increase. This increase still leaves our fees on average less than other comparable health departments.
