

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE FRANKLIN COUNTY OFFICE OF JUSTICE POLICY AND PROGRAMS (OJPP) IN SUPPORT OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ), COMPREHENSIVE OPIOID, STIMULANT, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SITE-BASED PROGRAM (COSSAP) GRANT (REVENUE OF APPROXIMATELY \$169,421.00).

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office of Justice Policy and Programs (OJPP) has been awarded a grant from the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) through the Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant, and Substance Abuse Site-Based Program (COSSAP) grant and seeks to enter into a contract with Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) to provide harm reduction services in support of the COSSAP grant;

WHEREAS, FCPH seeks to expand its harm reduction program in response to the overdose crisis and impact of illicit opioids, stimulants, or other substances; and

WHEREAS, with this grant, FCPH intends to deploy, replenish, and maintain two harm reduction vending machines, increase naloxone distribution to public safety, and expand its harm reduction/addiction workforce and education/ access to recovery support services.
