

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER TO CONTRACT WITH AND ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY AND CITY HEALTH OFFICIALS (NACCHO) FOR THE 2022-2023 HEALTHY BRAIN INITIATIVE (HBI) ROAD MAP STRATEGIST INITIATIVE GRANT. (REVENUE OF **\$48,000**)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) is committed to serving as a resource and leader in implementing the Center for Disease Control and Prevention's Healthy Brain Initiative, in alignment with Domain 3 of the Public Health Accreditation Board standards to Inform and Educate;

WHEREAS, the Healthy Brain Initiative is national effort to increase awareness of brain health and the high burden of Alzheimer's disease and related dementias through partnerships, collecting and reporting data, and addressing the needs of caregivers;

WHEREAS, the National Association of County and City Health Officials and National Alzheimer's Association have collaborated to host the second cohort of the Road Map Strategist Initiative to provide support, resources, and increase capacity of local health departments to promote brain health;

WHEREAS, in 2020, 10.3% of adults aged 65 years and older in Ohio reported subjective cognitive decline or memory loss and 24.3% of adults aged 65 years and older reported functional difficulties associated with cognitive decline or memory loss;

WHEREAS, FCPH will partner with the Alzheimer's Association – Central Ohio Chapter and African American Alzheimer's & Wellness Association to implement the best practices for aligning the agency's current chronic disease prevention education efforts to include brain health and increase public awareness in Franklin County;

1. That the Health Commissioner hereby accepts the compensation of \$48,000 from NACCHO for the HBI Road Map Strategist Initiative Grant (Revenue of \$48,000).
