

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER
TO RENEW A CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF COLUMBUS
FOR LEAD-BASED PAINT INSPECTIONS, RISK ASSESSMENTS,
WORK SPECIFICATIONS AND CLEARANCE TESTING SERVICES
(REVENUE OF \$90,000)

WHEREAS, the original contract was approved on January 14, 2020 through Resolution 20-005 in the amount of \$45,000.00 and was amended on April 14, 2020 and authorized by Resolution 20-046 in the amount of \$45,000.00;

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus is in need of lead-based paint inspections, risk assessments, work specifications and clearance testing services;

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health can provide the City of Columbus with said lead-based paint inspections, risk assessments, work specifications and clearance testing services for the Lead Safe Grant Program;

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health may participate in operating any federal program pursuant to Section 3709.282 of the Ohio Revised Code and such lead program is a federal program; and

WHEREAS, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goals to connect environmental health work to social determinants of health, equitable policies and practices, and sustainable funding.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS:

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to renew a contract with the City of Columbus Development Department for lead-based paint inspections, risk assessments, work specifications and clearance testing services (revenue of \$90,000).
2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption through December 31, 2023.
