

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH
COMMISSIONER TO SIGN A MODIFICATION
AGREEMENT WITH THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION
OF COUNTY AND CITY HEALTH OFFICIALS
(NACCHO) DE-OBLIGATING FUNDS FROM THE
CLIMATE CHANGE DEMONSTRATION GRANT
FROM 2021

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) was awarded funding in 2021 from the National Association of City County Health Officials (NACCHO) in the amount of \$14,659.23;

WHEREAS, due to the COVID Pandemic, staff did not travel as outlined in original contract budget;

WHEREAS, the position receiving funding had not yet been filled and was subsequently filled at a different salary than originally budgeted for in the contract;

WHEREAS, the difference in the funding awarded and the funding invoiced was a difference of \$3,160.36

WHEREAS, NACCHO seeks to de-obligate the funds from its records;
