WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) was awarded a grant from the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) through the Advancing Health Literacy Grant; and

WHEREAS, FCPH continues to advance COVID- 19 Health Literacy efforts with strong collaboration among local entities, and the support of HHS through this Advancing Health Literacy grant; and

WHEREAS, FCPH and subject matter experts will continue to design and deliver Reader Friendly Plain Language training, and provide updates to their Organizational Health Literacy guidebook for the purpose of incorporating and sustaining health literacy-informed approaches into COVID-related communication and healthcare system practices; and

WHEREAS, FCPH collaborated with the following agencies in support of the grant: Audrey Riffenburgh, PhD, DBA Health Literacy Connection (No cost extension of the original amount \$22,500.00); and Sabrina Kurtz-Rossi (No cost extension of the original amount \$22,500.00); and

WHEREAS, the board of health approved resolution 21-55

WHEREAS, the original contract amount of \$45,000.00 has not been fully expensed, and work will continue throughout the remaining grant project period through June 30, 2023
