

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FRANKLIN COUNTY ALCOHOL, DRUG ADDICTION AND MENTAL HEALTH BOARD (ADAMH) FOR THE STATE OPIOID AND STIMULANT RESPONSE (SOS) 3.0 GRANT. (REVENUE OF \$174,815.85)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been awarded funding from the ADAMH Board through a grant provided by the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services for the purpose of building an integrated behavioral health system continuum of care for individuals with a primary diagnosis of opiate use disorder or stimulant use disorder; and

WHEREAS, FCPH intends to dispatch a dedicated street outreach team expanding outreach and engagement to services with a focus on engaging individuals in active addiction, family members/friends, and community members; and

WHEREAS, with this funding FCPH anticipates serving individuals with opioid use disorders, stimulant use and other co-occurring substance use disorders. FCPH will also target minority populations, New Americans and reproductive aged women that have been sex trafficked or abused or pregnant women. Within the second year of the project FCPH expects to engage 1,200 people through the mobilized street outreach team and services. Of the total, FCPH's goal is for 50% to identify as at least one of the aforementioned target populations.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to accept funding from the Franklin County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Board for the State Opioid and Stimulant Response 3.0 Grant. (Revenue of \$174,815.85)
