RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT NO.\_\_\_\_BETWEEN THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH AND NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY AND CITY HEALTH OFFICIALS (NACCHO) FOR ADDRESSING NEEDS OF PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES IN COVID-19. (REVENUE OF \$75,000.00).

**WHEREAS**, NACCHO provides grant funding to local health departments for Emergency Preparedness services which addresses the needs of people with disabilities including COVID-19 planning, mitigation, and recovery efforts;

**WHEREAS**, NACCHO will make up to 12 awards available to local health departments with awards up to \$75,000 for the opportunity to address the needs of people with disabilities in emergency preparedness, including COVID-19 planning, mitigation, and recovery efforts;

**WHEREAS**, the main activities of the project include (1) embedding disability specialists, who will serve as subject matter experts, in local public health emergency preparedness planning and response programs; (2) increasing partnerships between local health departments and local disability organizations and (3) updating local emergency response plans to better serve the needs of people with disabilities during outbreaks, pandemics, and other national emergencies, and

**WHEREAS**, NACCHO and Franklin County Public Health are authorized to enter into an agreement pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section\_\_\_\_\_.
