FRANKLIN COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH SEEKS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR INTERIM FUNDING SUPPORT OF THE INTEGRATED NALOXONE INFRASTRUCTURE AND ACCESS GRANT (IN23) FOR THE NALOXONE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health has previously been awarded the Integrated Naloxone Infrastructure and Access (IN23) grant under the Ohio Department of Health,

WHEREAS, the IN23 grant is due to end on 12/31/2022, and a new funding opportunity will not begin until 4/1/2023,

WHEREAS, The Ohio Department of Health has offered a funding extension, not to exceed an award of \$20,000, for the period of 01/01/2023 – 03/31/2023, to continue naloxone education and distribution efforts during this time.

WHEREAS, FCPH seeks to utilize the IN23 Grant funds by working with local organizations with related initiatives and operations, specifically the Franklin County Office of Justice Policy and Programs ("OJPP"), Jordan's Crossing Resource Center ("Jordan's Crossing"), to provide services that will further the IN23 Grant initiatives

Now, therefore, upon motion of Board Member _____, second by Board Member _____;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That Franklin County Public Health is authorized to enter into a contract agreement with the Ohio Department of Health to extend funding for the Naloxone Program from 01/01/2023 - 03/31/2023.
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
