

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH TWO LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS TO HOST FRANKLIN COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH'S HARM REDUCTION VENDING MACHINES (HRVM)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has purchased two harm reduction vending machines with The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Overdose Data to Action funds; and

WHEREAS, FCPH has established partnerships with Peers Enriching Each Other's Recovery (PEER) Center and Jordan's Crossing Resource Center, each organization has agreed to host one of the HRVMs; and

WHEREAS, FCPH agrees to stock each organization's HRVM with HRVM supplies (naloxone, fentanyl test strips, first aid kits, safe sex kits, and pregnancy tests); provide technical support related to the HRVMs; host quarterly and monthly check-in meetings; and provide each organization with quarterly reports on HRVM usage, demographic data of participants and any feedback received from participants; and

WHEREAS, each organization agrees to host a HRVM at their location with the intent to complete the following activities: distribute and post promotional materials at onsite location to promote the HRVMs; promote on their social media pages; attend required technical support meetings with Area Wide/VendNovation; participate in monthly and quarterly check-in meetings with FCPH and other HRVM hosts; and monitor HRVMs for stock, technical issues, vandalism and theft.

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into agreements with two local organizations to host FCPHs HRVMs
