

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER
TO ACCEPT THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH
ASSOCIATION (NEHA) AND US FOOD & DRUG
ADMINISTRATION (FDA) RETAIL FLEXIBLE FUNDING
MODEL (RFFM) GRANT FOR THE FRANKLIN COUNTY
2023 TRAINING PROJECT (REVENUE OF \$7,500)

WHEREAS, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goal of connecting environmental health work to social determinants of health, creating equitable policies and practices diversifying funding;

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been selected by the National Environmental Health Association (NEHA) and US Food & Drug Administration (FDA) for the Retail Flexible Funding Model (RFFM) Grant for the Retail Standards Project;

WHEREAS, The FDA Voluntary National Retail Food Regulatory Program Standards (Retail Program Standards) encourage regulatory agencies to improve and build upon existing programs;

WHEREAS, the Retail Program Standards are intended to reinforce proper sanitation (good retail practices) and operational and environmental prerequisite programs while encouraging regulatory agencies and industry to focus on the factors that cause and contribute to foodborne illness, with the goal of reducing the occurrence of those factors;

WHEREAS, this grant will allow FCPH to send one (1) team member to the following conferences: NEHA, Conference for Food Protection, AFDO Conference, The Food Safety Summit, and/or AFIP to bring back for dissemination to the team to help fulfill requirements of the program; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health seeks to accept a grant award of \$7,500.00 for the period January 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Board of Health authorizes the Health Commissioner to enter into an agreement to accept grant funding from the National Environmental Health Association and US Food and Drug Administration (Revenue of \$7,500).
