RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE SCHEDULE
OF FEES FOR PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS
AND SPAS FOR THE 2023 LICENSING YEAR

WHEREAS, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goal of sustainable funding;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 3709.09 and 3749.04 of the Ohio Revised Code and sections 3701-31-02 and 3701-31-03 of the Ohio Administrative Code, the Board has the authority to set fees for the pool and spa program; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Health Division, in collaboration with the Office of Finance and Business Operations, performed the cost methodology based on 2022 data to establish fees for the 2023 operating/licensing year.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the pool and spa program fees for the 2023 licensing year are adopted effective ten days after the first publication following the third reading.
2. The Board directed the Health Commissioner to notify each person or government entity holding a pool or spa license of the proposed fee changes and their opportunity to attend this public hearing on March 14, 2023.
3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
