**WHEREAS**, the goal of this software is to give government communicators better insight into the needs of citizens and improves their ability to enhance online transactions, promote behavior change through public awareness, and improve citizen engagement;

**WHEREAS**, by leveraging the Cloud, FCPH will be able to utilize a number of different outreach mediums, including email, SMS/text messages, RSS feeds, and social media integration to connect with its target audiences; and

**WHEREAS**, Granicus gives FCPH added streamlined marketing capabilities that incorporate greater degrees of audience segmentation, personalization, message testing, and mobile engagement.
