

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CARAHSOFT TECHNOLOGY GROUP TO PROVIDE CLOUD-BASED SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS FOR THE PLUMBING AND MEDICAL GAS SECTION AND THE RABIES VACCINATION TAG PROGRAM PENDING THE APPROVAL FROM THE FRANKLIN COUNTY AUTOMATIC DATA PROCESSING BOARD (Expense not to exceed \$440,350.04 – ARPA Funding)

WHEREAS, it is necessary to replace the existing software/database used for the Plumbing and Medical Gas Section, which is antiquated, no longer serves the needs of FCPH, and does not provide access to contractors, the public, and jurisdictions we serve;

WHEREAS, the cloud-based software Accela developed by Carahsoft for the Plumbing and Medical Gas Section will include, but is not limited to, contractor registration, plans submission and review, permitting, payments, inspection requests, inspection documentation, invoicing, reports, a customer portal, and the incorporation of ArcGIS;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to replace the existing database used for the Rabies Vaccination Tag System, which is antiquated, cannot be updated, and is built on a platform no longer supported by the Franklin County Data Center beyond the 3rd quarter of 2023; and

WHEREAS, the cloud-based software Accela developed by Carahsoft for the Rabies Vaccination Tag Program will include, but is not limited to, the creation of veterinary clinic accounts, receive requests for rabies tag orders, record rabies tag fulfilment, receive payment, tag inventory, account ledgers, invoice creation, and the ability to allow Columbus Public Health to have access to the functions of the software.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into a contract with Carahsoft for a cloud- based software solution for the Plumbing and Medical Gas Section, and the Rabies Vaccination Tag Program. Total expense for software development, implementation, and one-year of user licenses (EXPENSE NOT TO EXCEED \$440,350.04 -ARPA FUNDING)
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
