

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR FY2023-2024 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS (PHEP) REGIONAL GRANT & CITIES READINESS INITIATIVE Grant BETWEEN JULY 1, 2023, TO JUNE 30, 2024. (REVENUE NOT TO EXCEED \$178,551.00 – PHEP REGIONAL & CRI GRANT FUNDING);

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Health provides federal grant funding for the Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Regional Grant and Cities Readiness Initiative (CRI) grant; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health is responsible for designated areas of the jurisdiction and is required by the Ohio Department of Health to perform the emergency preparedness services; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health are authorized to enter into an agreement for Emergency Preparedness activities to best serve both the residents of Franklin County and the Central Ohio Region; and

WHEREAS, this is the fifth year of a five-year grant cycle for PHEP Regional & CRI funding; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Preparedness program and activities aligns with Franklin County Public Health PHAB accreditation measurement 5.4;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into a contract with Ohio Department of Health to provide PHEP Regional and CRI Services for estimated revenue of \$178,551.00 based on the terms and conditions of the contract.
