

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENGAGE WITH PRIMARYONE HEALTH TO BECOME A CO-SPONSOR OF A QUARTERLY HEALTH ADVOCACY BREAKFAST (EXPENSE NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000.00)

WHEREAS, in its 2019-2023 Strategic Plan Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) identified an objective to increase its internal and external education and engagement regarding the SDoH;

WHEREAS, the data in the most recent community health assessment reaffirms the strong relationship between equity and social determinants. The data suggests a need to work towards common outcomes by integrating FCPH efforts with agencies, community partners, and coalitions addressing: economic stability, housing and neighborhoods, education, social and community connections, food and nutrition and finally transportation;

WHEREAS, PrimaryOne Health Community Health Center currently hosts Quarterly Community Health Advocacy Breakfasts. These forums are designed to help residents and partners understand the healthcare landscape in our community and how SDOH can and do affect health outcomes. The forums also provide information to assist in advocating for healthcare, social and other policies, funding, and programs to meet the needs of our community and residents;

WHEREAS, PrimaryOne Health has requested FCPH become a sponsoring organization of the Quarterly Community Health Advocacy Breakfasts including nominal costs for food, promotion, location, topic selection, partner engagement and agenda setting; and;

WHEREAS, the outcomes of this collaboration will align with the FCPH strategic plan and help advance the outcomes of the upcoming Community Health Improvement Plan.
