RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO EXTEND THE DATA USE AGREEMENT WITH HEART OF OHIO FAMILY HEALTH CENTER - WHITEHALL FOR THE USE BY THE PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE (PHN) LED HOME VISITING PROGRAM. (NO COST)

**WHEREAS**, health disparities persist for women of color and their infants which leads to poor birth outcomes and an increased infant mortality rate in Franklin County;

**WHEREAS**, home visiting is a proven intervention to improve prenatal and postpartum birth outcomes;

**WHEREAS**, FCPH is piloting a public health nurse led, client centered, team based home visiting intervention for prenatal and postpartum women of color and their families in partnership with Heart of Ohio Family Health Centers;

**WHEREAS**, data sharing agreement authorized by Resolution No. 20-031 is critical to provide comprehensive, patient centered care and

**WHEREAS**, the revision to the data use agreement between FCPH and Heart of Ohio for use through the Community Partnership Grant (Public Health Nurse Led Home Visiting program) specifically states that it allows assigned FCPH staff to access and document in Heart of Ohio's electronic health record system.
