RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CONTINUING EDUCATION (CE) BOARDS FOR THE 2023 ACES, PACES AND ADDICTION SUMMIT. (EXPENSE NOT TO EXCEED \$885.00 CDC OD2A FUNDS).

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) as part of its CDC Overdose Data to Action project, will host a 1-day in-person Summit at the Quest Conference Center to understand risk and protective factors for addiction, to share learnings and intervention strategies implemented in the County since the first Summit in 2021. This allows an opportunity to be better equipped to treat addiction both in the near-term, through treatment in children and adults who have experienced ACEs, as well as in the next generation; and

**WHEREAS**, the summit will be held in-person only on July 24, 2023, and organizational partners from a variety of sectors and disciplines will be invited, FCPH is offering CE credits to encourage attendance; and

WHEREAS, FCPH has identified multiple boards to request CEs relevant to presenters and panelists. These boards include Ohio Counselor, Social Worker, and Marriage and Family Therapist Board; Ohio Chemical Dependency Professionals Board; and

**WHEREAS**, this project aligns with the agency strategic plan by providing external education related to the Social Determinants of Health (SDOH).
