RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HEALTH IMPACT OHIO (HIO) AS A SUBLICENSEE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC ENTITY PATHWAYS COMMUNITY HUB INSTITUTE (PCHI), AGREEMENT TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE CARE COORDINATION SERVICES THROUGH THE UPDATED CENTRAL OHIO PATHWAYS HUB MODEL 2.0. (NO REVENUE OR EXPENSE INVOLVED)

- **WHEREAS**, PCHI is the national certifying organization for programs that have adopted and been determined to be implementing the evidence-based, outcome-oriented PCHI Model with fidelity; and
- **WHEREAS**, PCHI certifies Pathways Community HUBs (PCH), Pathways Agencies (PA), Technology Vendors (TV), and Community Health Worker (CHW) Instructors (CHWI). PCHs, PAs, and TVs may each be Sublicensors.; and
- **WHEREAS**, Health Impact Ohio (HIO) is designated as primary Sublicensor receiving a non-exclusive license from PCHI and is permitted to sublicense certain rights provided in the license to sublicensees; and
- WHEREAS, HIO will grant the FCPH Care Coordination program a sublicense under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement to support the implementation of the PCHI Model in its role as the Care Coordination Agency, and PCHI Sublicense status will allow the Care Coordination program to continue its work within the Central Ohio Pathways HUB; and
- WHEREAS, the Care Coordination program aligns with the agency Strategic Plan and the services the CHWs provide addresses the four priority health areas within HealthMap 2022 and the agency's Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP).
