RESOLUTION TO AMEND Resolution # 22-107 APPROVED ON JULY 12, 2022, BETWEEN THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH AND MID-OHIO REGIONAL PLANNING COMISSION (MORPC) IN SUPPORT OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH 2022-2023 HEALTH EATING AND ACTIVE LIVING (HEAL) GRANT (EXPENSE OF \$19,000.00);

WHEREAS, FCPH requests that the Board amend Resolution # 22-107 approved on July 12, 2022 to extend the contract end date from June 30, 2023 to September 22, 2023, as the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) has extended the grant period for all awardees.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) awarded Franklin County Public Health with the Healthy Eating Active Living (HEAL) grant with the purpose of supporting activities and implementing strategies that promote physical activity and active transportation.

WHEREAS, Areas in Franklin Township and Reynoldsburg scored 1 on the CDC's Social Vulnerability Index, indicating extensive barriers to accessing resources related to the social determinants of health, including access to safe opportunities for physical activity.

WHEREAS, FCPH will extend its contract with Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission who will provide subject knowledge expertise in completing activities outlined in the scope of work, including, continuing to assist FCPH with building capacity in Franklin Township to develop an Active Transportation Plan and working with the City of Reynoldsburg to develop and pass a Complete Streets policy, allowing for safer roadways for those using alternative modes of transportation (i.e. walking and biking).

WHEREAS, all other terms outlined of the original agreement and conditions not expressly modified from herein shall remain in full force effect;

WHEREAS, FCPH and MORPC will work together in achieving both Domains 5 and 7 of the Public Health Accreditation Board (PHAB) by developing the Complete Streets policy and Active Transportation plan that will enable safe use and support mobility for all users, increasing access to health care services.
