RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MORROW COUNTY HEALTH DISTRICT FOR FY2023-2024 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS (PHEP) & CITIES READINESS INITIATIVE (CRI) GRANT BETWEEN JULY 1, 2023, TO JUNE 30, 2024 (REVENUE OF \$46,312.90 – PHEP & CRI GRANT FUNDING);

WHEREAS, FCPH and MCHD serve to protect the health, safety and well-being of the residents of their respective jurisdictions by providing quality public health services;

WHEREAS, protecting residents from threats related to public health emergencies is a necessary function of the health districts;

WHEREAS, Public Health Emergency Preparedness (“PHEP”) and Cities Readiness Initiative (“CRI”) dollars are Federal grant dollars intended to assist the health districts in meeting the preparedness needs; and

WHEREAS, MCHD has a need for a coordinator for PHEP and CRI, and FCPH has a competent, experienced coordinator(s) with the capacity to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, this is the fifth year of a five year grant cycle for PHEP & CRI funding; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Preparedness program and activities aligns with Franklin County Public Health PHAB accreditation measurement 5.4;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH BOARD MEMBERS;
