

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS OHIO, COMPDRUG, ETHIOPIAN TEWAHEDO SOCIAL SERVICES, HEALTH POLICY INSTITUTE OF OHIO WE ARE LINDEN TO AWARD ACES PREVENTION AND RESILIENCY MINI-GRANTS AS PART OF THE 2023 ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCES (ACES) SUMMIT. (EXPENSE NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000.00 FUNDS WILL BE PAID OUT OF CDC OD2A AND ARPA FUNDS).

WHEREAS, 20% of Ohio children are exposed to one or more adverse childhood experiences (ACEs), which have both immediate and long-term effects on health; and

WHEREAS, FCPH is hosting a summit to discuss the public health importance of aces and programming related to aces prevention; and intends to fund four (4) ACEs, PACEs, and Addiction prevention and resiliency projects, with each applicant eligible to request up to \$25,000 as a one-time funding opportunity; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposal (RFP) was released on 5/25/2023 with applications due on 6/14/2023 and awards to be made at the Summit on July 24, 2023. Proposals were ranked on: the extent to which the project focuses on supporting prevention and community resiliency within Franklin County, extent to which ACEs prevention strategies were clearly identified and addressed by the proposed activities; and

WHEREAS, applications were reviewed by a panel of evaluators, including FCPH Leadership, epidemiologists, and programmatic staff; and

WHEREAS, this project aligns with PHAB Domains 4.1.1 (Foster cross-sector collaboration to advance equity), and 4.1.3 (Engage with community members to address public health issues and promote health).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into contract with After School All-Stars Ohio, Mental Health America of Ohio, Ethiopian Tewahedo Social Services (ETSS), Health Policy Institute of Ohio (HPIO) to conduct ACEs, PACEs, and Addiction prevention and resiliency projects. Funds to be awarded at the 2023 ACES Summit. (Expense not to exceed \$100,000.00)
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
