Hello Mr. & Mrs. Spencer,

The tax and property records on file with the Franklin County Auditor's and/or Recorder's Office identify you as the owners of said property. After an observation performed in the field on **4-5-2022**, it was found that an after-market motor was in the **Jet** aeration treatment system serving the residential structure.

In accordance with OAC 3701-29-13 (sections B and C), the aerobic sewage treatment system must use a device (aeration motor) that satisfies the manufacturers and Ohio Department of Health standards of treatment.

To bring the property into compliance the following action is required:

- You may submit the model of aeration motor currently in the system for technical review to the Ohio Department of Health, to judge the devices capacity for sewage treatment.
- 2. Barring approval of the current after-market aerator for use in the system, or if you choose not to submit the current after-market motor to the Ohio Department of Health for consideration, you must replace the after-market aeration motor in the system with a Jet aeration device.

You will be given until May 13, 2022 to comply with this notice of violation. A re-inspection will be performed on or thereafter to verify compliance. If these violations are not corrected, this matter may result in further administrative enforcement, or criminal charges or a civil lawsuit being filed in the Franklin County Municipal Court, Environmental Division
