

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CORA MUNOZ, PhD, RN IN SUPPORT OF GRANT DELIVERABLES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES (HHS), OFFICE OF MINORITY HEALTH (OMH), AND ADVANCING HEALTH LITERACY (AHL) GRANT IN FRANKLIN COUNTY (EXPENSE OF \$2,000.00)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been awarded funding from the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to advance health literacy in Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, with this grant FCPH and its local partners will increase organizational health literacy in Franklin County by offering training on cultural competency and implementation of Culturally and Linguistically Appropriate Services (CLAS) standards to improve the quality of services provided to all individuals, which will ultimately help reduce health disparities and achieve health equity; and

WHEREAS, FCPH will contract with Dr. Cora Munoz to provide training on cultural competency and implementation of CLAS standards in support of increasing organizational health literacy within Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Cora Munoz will provide 2 virtual 60-minute trainings on cultural competency with an Asian population focus and touch on the CLAS standards to Advancing Health Literacy Franklin County partners and community members.;

WHEREAS, CLAS also advances the organization's DEI work and supports the FCPH Declaration of Racism is a Public Health Crisis, the FCPH Workforce Development Plan, and aligns with the Public Health Accreditation Board (PHAB) standards and measures.
