RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CITY AND COUNTY HEALTH OFFICIALS FOR THE PARTNERING FOR DISEASE FORECASTING AND ANALYTICS (Revenue of \$75,000)

**WHEREAS**, the National Association of City and County Health Officials (NACCHO) supports local health department efforts to develop public health policies and programs to ensure communities have access to vital programs and services to protect communities from disease and disaster;

**WHEREAS**, NACCHO, with support from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Center for Forecasting and Outbreak Analytics, and will provide funding to strengthen local health departments capacity to integrate forecasting and analytical tools into infectious disease outbreak planning and response at the local level;

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been selected by NACCHO as a demonstration site with support from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to implement tools and methodologies to enable the department to proactively predict and analyze disease outbreaks, thereby improving public health response and mitigating the impact of infectious diseases.;

**WHEREAS**, deliverables will include, carrying out hands-on training, simulations, and exercises to increase decision-maker capacity to translate analytic results into public health actions and policy development; and

**WHEREAS**, these deliverables align with FCPH's efforts in translating the health implications of identified trends and hot spots into program planning and development and additionally decreasing FCPH's funding reliance on the contracted cities, townships, and villages;
