

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CENTRAL OHIO PATHWAYS HUB TO BE RECOGNIZED AS A PARTICIPATING CARE COORDINATION AGENCY IN THE HUBS OHIO COMMISSION ON MINORITY HEALTH (OCMH) GRANT APPLICATION. (ESTIMATED MINIMUM OF \$10,000.00 IN REVENUE)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) serves as a Care Coordination Agency through the Central Ohio Pathways HUB and utilizes the standardized Pathways Community HUB model to address health disparities; and

WHEREAS, the agreement would allow the Central Ohio Pathways HUB to utilize FCPH CHW data to count minority pregnant clients in the grant processes, as well as allow FCPH to receive incentive payments for completed social service, medical, pregnancy and postpartum pathways; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, FCPH's Care Coordination program received \$11,221.00 of incentive payments through the OCMH grant through the completion of pathways and healthy birthweight pregnancies; and

WHEREAS, the agreement aligns with PHAB Domain 7: Contribute to an effective system that enables equitable access to the individual services and care needed to be healthy, and address FCPH's newly released Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) priority area Maternal and Infant Health.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Central Ohio Pathways HUB to be recognized as a participating care coordination agency in the HUBS Ohio Commission on Minority Health (OCMH) grant application. (Estimated minimum of \$10,000.00 in revenue)
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
