

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO AMEND RESOLUTION 23-054 THE CONTRACT WITH OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR FY2023-2024 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS (PHEP) CITIES READINESS INITIATIVE GRANT BETWEEN JULY 1, 2023, TO JUNE 30, 2024. (REVENUE \$4,805.00 – CRI GRANT FUNDING)

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Health provides federal grant funding for the Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Cities Readiness Initiative (CRI) grant; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health is responsible for designated areas of the jurisdiction and is required by the Ohio Department of Health to perform the emergency preparedness services; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health are authorized to enter into an agreement for Emergency Preparedness activities to best serve the residents of Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, this is the fifth year of a five year grant cycle for PHEP CRI funding with the addition of a new grant deliverable 8.1 – Equitable MCM Proposal Worksheet; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Preparedness program and activities aligns with Franklin County Public Health PHAB accreditation measurement 5.4.
