

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AGREEMENT WITH THE FRANKLIN COUNTY OFFICE OF JUSTICE POLICY AND PROGRAMS FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING MEDICALLY ASSISTED TREATMENT PROGRAM PEER SUPPORT SERVICES (REVENUE NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000.00)

WHEREAS, the opioid epidemic has had a significant impact on the continuity of care for justice-involved individuals in the Franklin County and/or Central Ohio Region; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health, recognizes the importance of contributing to the capacity of Peer Support Services to ensure a smooth transition and continuity of care for individuals interested in receiving medically assisted treatment for opioid use disorder upon release from the Franklin County Jail; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health, in partnership with the Franklin County Office of Justice Policy and Programs, has undertaken the responsibility of implementing pre- and post-release peer support services to ensure individuals continue to be engaged in treatment and recovery opportunities; and

WHEREAS, this partnership aligns with PHAB Domain Standard 7.2., connect individuals to services that support the whole person.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into a contract agreement with The Franklin County Office of Justice Policy and Programs for the purpose of implementing medically assisted treatment program peer support services, (revenue not to exceed \$30,000.00).
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
