RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENGAGE WITH THE OHIO LEGISLATURE REGARDING HOUSE BILL (HB) 47

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Resolution is to authorize FCPH staff to educate the Ohio Legislature regarding House Bill (HB) 47 and not to advocate or lobby;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the bill is to require the placement of automated external defibrillators (AEDs) in each public and chartered non-public school and each public recreational facility and to require the Ohio Department of Health to develop a model emergency action plan for the use of AEDs;

WHEREAS, Franklin County Health Commissioner is a member of the Central Ohio American Heart Association Board of Directors;

WHEREAS, State Representative Brown is a lead sponsor who represents portions of Franklin County Public Health's jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Hypertension Network, co-chaired by Franklin County Public Health and the American Heart Association, is acknowledged in the 2023 Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP);

WHEREAS, accreditation standard 6.1.2 states Information provided to the governing entity and/or elected / appointed officials concerning needed updates / amendments to current laws and/or proposed new laws

Now, therefore, upon motion of Board Member __, second by Board Member __;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to engage with members of the Ohio House and Ohio Senate from Franklin County regarding HB 47 for purposes of education as to public health significance of the proposed legislation.
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
