RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ADOPT AND APPROVE AGENCY USE OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (ODH) UPDATED INFECTIOUS DISEASE CONTROL MANUAL (IDCM) AS A PROTOCOL FOR ALL REPORTABLE INFECTIOUS DISEASES

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) is responsible for investigating reportable communicable and infectious diseases within its health jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the IDCM is a project of the Ohio Department of Health State Bureau of Infectious Diseases. It is designed to be a reference for local health departments, hospitals, laboratories, and physicians in providing information about infectious diseases from a public health perspective, including prevention, control and reporting of suspected and diagnosed cases;

WHEREAS, this manual is updated at least annually to reflect changes in public health practices and disease prevention and control activities;

WHEREAS, the adoption of the updated IDCM by FCPH will be used as protocol for all reportable infectious diseases listed with a table of contents for investigating all infectious diseases; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this policy, aligns with PHAB Accreditation Standard 2.1: Anticipate, prevent, and mitigate health threats through surveillance and investigation of health problems and environmental hazards. Resolution 24-004 Page 2 January 9, 2024
