RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CENTRAL OHIO MOBILE CONSORTIUM (COMC) FOR THE PURPOSE OF LEAVERAGING MOBILE UNIT CARE (NO COST)

**WHEREAS**, the Central Ohio Mobile Consortium (COMC) comprises healthcare entities operating mobile units within Central Ohio. Members of the COMC unite with a shared objective of eradicating health inequities by harnessing the capabilities of mobile unit care to diminish access barriers for underserved communities and neighborhoods;

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) aims to enhance its influence by partnering with COMC to create and utilize a mobile app dedicated to improving access and awareness of mobile unit care within the community (referred to as the "App");

**WHEREAS**, The collaboration involves utilizing community-accessible data to jointly identify health-related trends and gaps in healthcare, implementing shared quality improvement interventions to address identified needs. Additionally, the initiative aims to make mobile units available to support the community's emergency preparedness plan; and

**WHEREAS**, FCPH commits to providing data for inclusion in both the COMC Data Collection System and the App.
